Communion Stations- When looking at the stations from left to right: Farthest left is a kneeling station (kn), next is 3 standing stations (st), the middle is a self-communication station, then to the right are 3 more standing stations and farthest right is one kneeling station. An additional kneeling station as well as prayer intercessors, anointing oil and communion is available in the chapel.
